



## Guidance for parents/carers regarding Medication

**The Medical Consent Form completed and signed by parents/carers at the Formal Interview will remain in place throughout the child's period at Hunters Hill unless we are notified otherwise in writing by parents/carers. Please note the following:-**

- A new medical consent form is required each time there is a change to your child's medication. Please request blank consent forms from the School Office at any time.
- Only medication prescribed by a doctor can routinely be given in School.
- Medication must be handed into School in person and not given to your child or put in your child's school bag. In most cases medication can be handed to the taxi driver who will deliver it to an adult in School.
- Medication sent into School must be in its original container and be clearly labelled by the pharmacist with the following information:-
  - Your child's name
  - The name of the medication
  - The strength of the medication
  - The amount of medication, e.g. number of tablets/mls in the bottle
  - The dose to be given and how often
  - The date it was dispensed
